


#### Population pyramid

Age and sex profile of residents, bars indicate 2021 census population, lines show projected 2027 population.




### Ethnicity

Percentage of 2016 population by broad ethnic group.




#### Unemployment benefit and Universal credit claimants

Graph showing the count of Universal credit and job seeker allowance claimants over time.




#### Index of Multiple Deprivation map

Numbers in employment by broad industry.






2020/21 is 69.0% this is similar to the England value of 65.9%.

deliberate injuries in children (aged 0-14 years) for Harborough in 2020/21 is 52.4 per 10,000 this is significantly better than the England value of 75.7 per 10,000.



The under 18s conception rate for Harborough in 2020 is 7.1 per 1,000 this is significantly better than the England value of 13.0 per 1,000.
