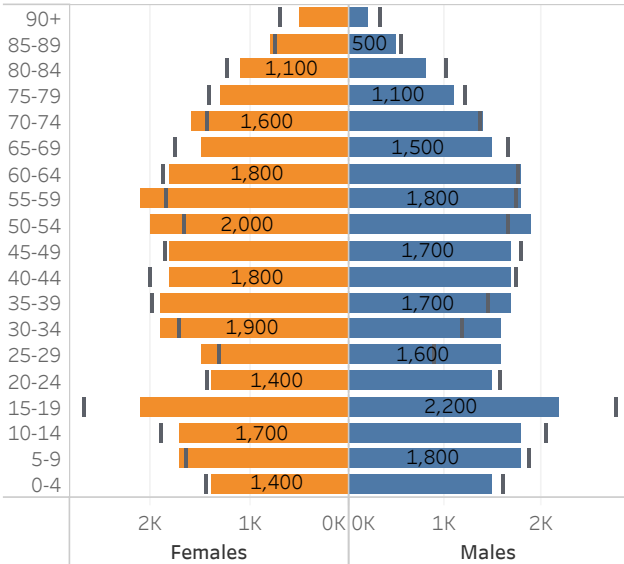

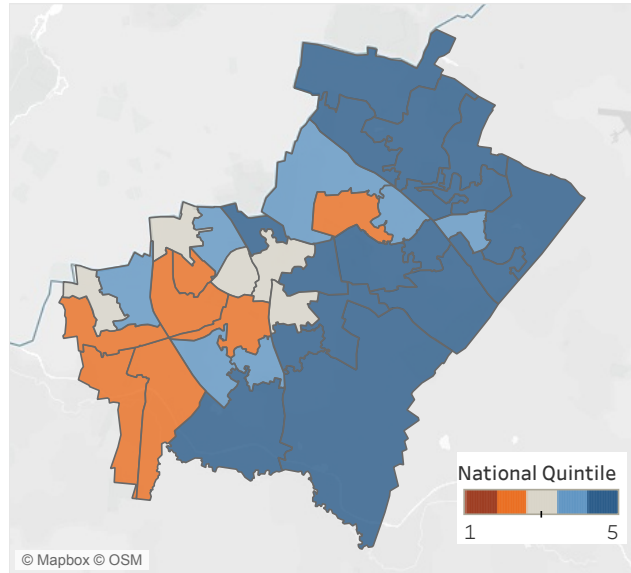
Population pyramid

Age and sex profile of residents, bars indicate 2021 census population, lines show projected 2027 population.



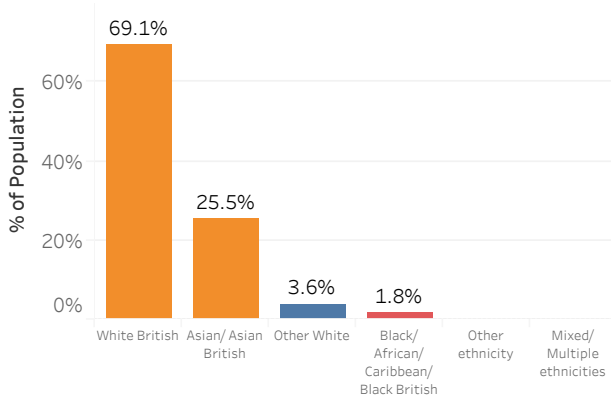
Index of Multiple Deprivation map

LSOA map showing national quintile performance of index of multiple deprivation score.



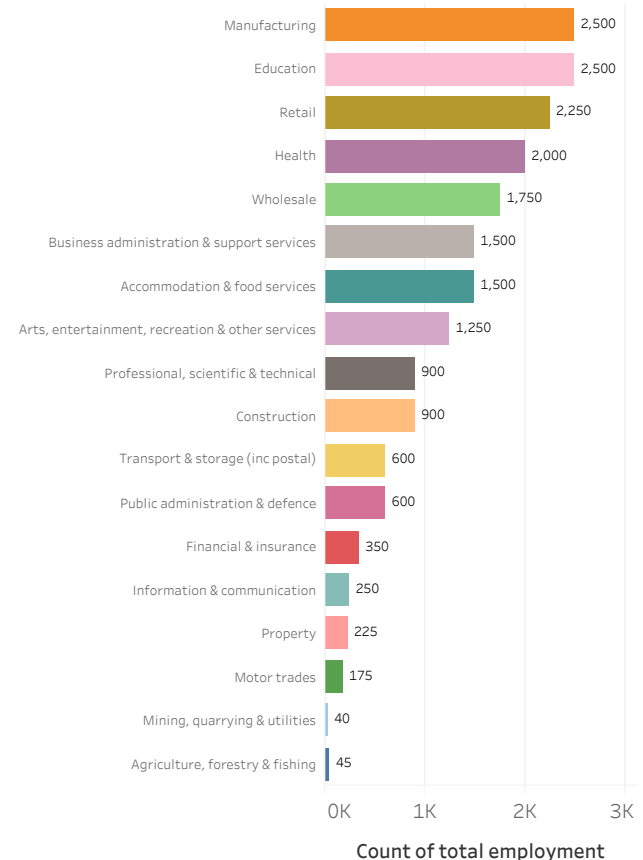
Ethnicity

Percentage of 2016 population by broad ethnic group.



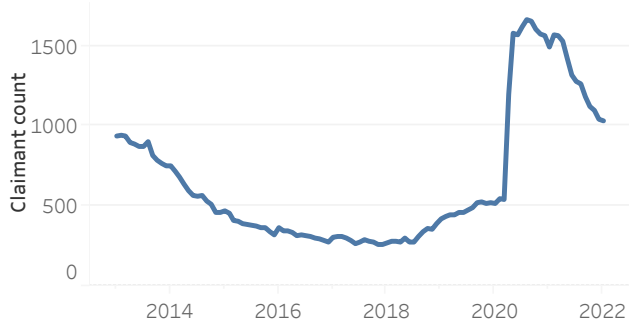
Occupations

Wider determinants

The number of premises licensed to sell alcohol per square kilometre for Oadby and Wigston in 2017/18 is 5.3 this is significantly worse than the England value of 1.3.



The density of fast food outlets for Oadby and Wigston in 2014 is 76.9 per 100,000 this is similar to the England value of 88.2 per 100,000.



The air pollution: fine particulate matter(historic) for Oadby and Wigston in 2020 is 6.6 µg/m3 this is not compared to the England value of 6.9 µg/m3.



The proportion of unpaid carers for Oadby and Wigston in 2011 is 2.4% this is similar to the England value of 2.4%.



The average weekly earnings for Oadby and Wigston in 2021 is £436.4 this is similar to the England value of £496.0.



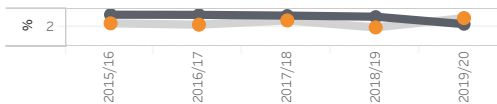
The gap in the employment rate between those with a long-term health condition and the overall employment rate for Oadby and Wigston in 2019/20 is 18.7 percentage points this is similar to the England value of 10.6 percentage points.



The violence offences per 1,000 population for Oadby and Wigston in 2020/21 is 23.2 per 1,000 this is not compared to the England value of 29.5 per 1,000.



The percentage of adults cycling for travel at least three days per week for Oadby and Wigston in 2019/20 is 3.0% this is similar to the England value of 2.3%.



The the rate of households owed a duty under the Homelessness Reduction Act for Oadby and Wigston in 2020/21 is 7.3 per 1,000 this is significantly better than the England value of 11.3 per 1,000.

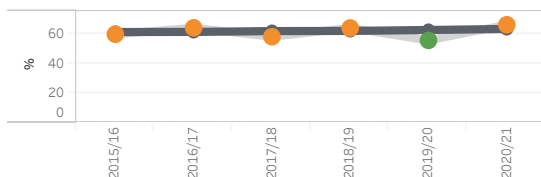


The percentage living in fuel poverty for Oadby and Wigston in 2018 is 8.9% this is not compared to the England value of 10.3%.



Health behaviours

The percentage of adults (aged 18+) classified as overweight or obese for Oadby and Wigston in 2020/21 is 66.3% this is similar to the England value of 63.5%.



The smoking prevalence in adults (18+) - current smokers (APS) for Oadby and Wigston in 2019 is 10.0% this is similar to the England value of 13.9%.



The percentage of physically active adults for Oadby and Wigston in 2020/21 is 59.0% this is significantly worse than the England value of 65.9%.



The proportion of the population meeting the recommended '5-a-day' on a 'usual day' (adults) for Oadby and Wigston in 2019/20 is 57.3% this is similar to the England value of 55.4%.

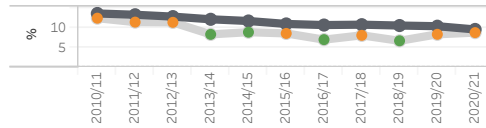

Early years

The proportion of low birth weight of term babies for Oadby and Wigston in 2020 is 3.6% this is similar to the England value of 2.9%.



The proportion of women smoking at time of delivery for Oadby and Wigston in 2020/21 is 8.8% this is similar to the England value of 9.6%.



The infant mortality rate for Oadby and Wigston in 2018 - 20 is 2.6 per 1,000 this is similar to the England value of 3.9 per 1,000.

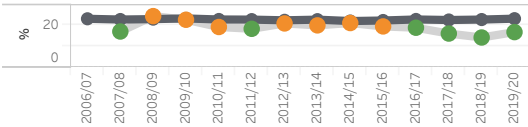


The breastfeeding initiation for Oadby and Wigston in 2016/17 is 69.3% this is significantly worse than the England value of 74.5%.

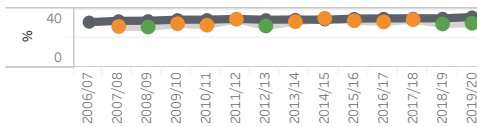


Wider determinants

The prevalence of overweight children (including obesity) in Reception for Oadby and Wigston in 2019/20 is 16.7% this is significantly better than the England value of 23.0%.



The prevalence of overweight children (including obesity) in Year 6 for Oadby and Wigston in 2019/20 is 30.9% this is significantly better than the England value of 35.2%.



The rate of households with dependent children owed a duty under the Homelessness Reduction Act for Oadby and Wigston in 2020/21 is 8.7 per 1,000 this is significantly better than the England value of 11.6 per 1,000.



The percentage of children in absolute low income families (under 16s) for Oadby and Wigston in 2019/20 is 12.0% this is significantly better than the England value of 15.6%.



The percentage of children providing unpaid care (aged 0-15) for Oadby and Wigston in 2011 is 0.9% this is significantly better than the England value of 1.1%.

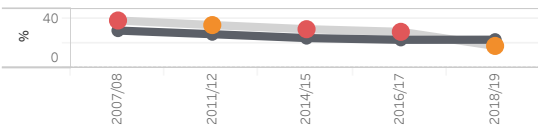


The average attainment 8 score for Oadby and Wigston in 2020/21 is 51.0 this is similar to the England value of 50.9.



Outcomes

The percentage of 5 year olds with experience of visually obvious dental decay for Oadby and Wigston in 2018/19 is 18.3% this is similar to the England value of 23.4%.



The C11b - Hospital admissions caused by unintentional and deliberate injuries in young people (aged 15-24 years) for Oadby and Wigston in 2020/21 is 59.0 per 10,000 this is significantly better than the England value of 112.4 per 10,000.



The rate of admissions caused by unintentional and deliberate injuries in children (aged 0-14 years) for Oadby and Wigston in 2020/21 is 35.4 per 10,000 this is significantly better than the England value of 75.7 per 10,000.



The under 18s conception rate for Oadby and Wigston in 2020 is 11.5 per 1,000 this is similar to the England value of 13.0 per 1,000.

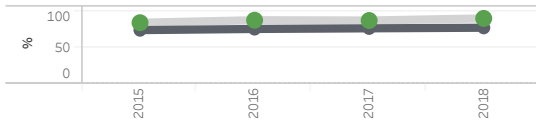

Diagnoses



The estimated diabetes diagnosis rate for Oadby and Wigston in 2018 is 90.9% this is significantly better than the England value of 78.0%.



The estimated dementia diagnosis rate (aged 65 and over) for Oadby and Wigston in 2021 is 61.6% this is similar to the target value of 66.7%.



The all new STI diagnosis rate / 100,000 for Oadby and Wigston in 2020 is 387.3 per 100,000 this is significantly lower than the England value of 562.2 per 100,000.



The percentage of cancers diagnosed at stages 1 & 2 for Oadby and Wigston in 2019 is 53.0% this is similar to the England value of 55.0%.

Admissions

The admission rate for alcohol-related conditions (Narrow): New method for Oadby and Wigston in 2020/21 is 365.3 per 100,000 this is significantly better than the England value of 455.9 per 100,000.



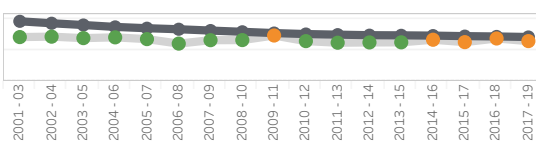
The rate of emergency hospital admissions due to falls in people aged 65 and over for Oadby and Wigston in 2020/21 is 1,691.8 per 100,000 this is significantly better than the England value of 2,023.0 per 100,000.



Mortality



The under 75 mortality rate from causes considered preventable (2019 definition) for Oadby and Wigston in 2017 - 19 is 129.1 per 100,000 this is similar to the England value of 142.2 per 100,000.



The suicide rate for Oadby and Wigston in 2018 - 20 is 9.7 per 100,000 this is similar to the England value of 10.4 per 100,000.



The under 75 mortality rate from cancer for Oadby and Wigston in 2017 - 19 is 123.2 per 100,000 this is similar to the England value of 129.2 per 100,000.



The under 75 mortality rate from all cardiovascular diseases for Oadby and Wigston in 2017 - 19 is 62.8 per 100,000 this is similar to the England value of 70.4 per 100,000.



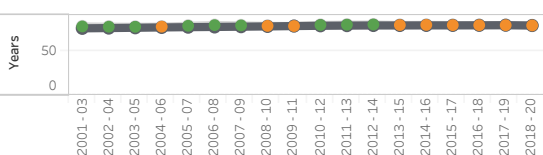
The under 75 mortality rate from respiratory disease for Oadby and Wigston in 2017 - 19 is 22.5 per 100,000 this is significantly better than the England value of 33.6 per 100,000.



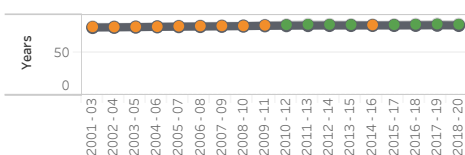
The excess winter deaths index for Oadby and Wigston in Aug 2019 - Jul 2020 is 25.3% this is similar to the England value of 17.4%.

Life Expectancy

The life expectancy at birth for males for Oadby and Wigston in 2018 - 20 is 79.5 years this is similar to England value of 79.4 years.



The life expectancy at birth for females for Oadby and Wigston in 2018 - 20 is 84.6 years this is significantly better than England value of 83.1 years.
